Newfoundland and Labrador

Guided by Bob and Teresa Marshall

June 25 - July 7, 2021: 13 Days

Join Teresa and Bob as they host this 13 day circle tour to Newfoundland and Labrador with Atlantic Tours and Travel. Discover a land filled with Viking history. Travel to a land overflowing with natural beauty. Boat tours provide the opportunity to see whales, icebergs and thousands of seabirds. From west to east, Newfoundland & Labrador will undoubtedly leave you with memories that will last a lifetime.



Day 1-2 - June 25-26: Vancouver - Deer Lake

- Door to door home pick up. WestJet (sold separately) overnight flight arriving in Deer Lake. Transfer to Corner Brook where you will spend the first night of your tour.

Day 3 - June 27: Corner Brook-Port au Choix (B/L/D)

- Meet our Tour Director or Driver/Guide and traveling companions. Our journey continues through Gros Morne National Park - to be enjoyed later on during your tour - to the fishing community of Port au Choix where we will overnight.

Day 4 - June 28: Port au Choix - L'Anse au Clair (B/D)

- Board the ferry from St. Barbe to cross the Strait of Belle Isle to Labrador. Continue to Red Bay National Historic Site where the Basques had a whaling station in the 16th century. Spend the night in Labrador.

Day 5 - June 29: L'Anse au Clair - St. Anthony (B/D)

- Return to Newfoundland and travel to L'Anse aux Meadows National Historic Site, the first cultural discovery in the world to receive recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Hear of the Vikings who walked here over a thousand years ago.

Day 6 - June 30: St. Anthony - Cow Head (B/D)

- Enjoy a morning whale watching boat tour in St. Anthony (weather permitting) before travelling to Cow Head for a two- night stay June and early July are the best time to see Titanic -size icebergs!

Day 7 - July 1: Gros Morne local touring (B/L/D)

- Discover why Gros Morne National Park is truly one of the highlights of your tour. Visit the Broom Point fishing exhibit and Lobster Cove Lighthouse. Enjoy a scenic boat tour (weather permitting) as you learn the geology of the Tablelands, see the bald eagles and hear the history of the small villages nestled on the shores. It is an unforgettable experience; the scenery is unequalled in eastern Canada. Option: Passengers may request on booking to take a scenic boat tour on Western Brook Pond and visit the Broom Point Fishing Premises in lieu of the scenic boat tour on Bonne Bay and visit the Tablelands. While some may consider the boat tour on Western Brook Pond to be a superior outing, please note that there is a 45-minute walk (3 km/2 miles) from the parking lot to the dock and a 45-minute walk back. This option must be requested on booking.

Day 8-July 2: Cow Head - Gander (B/D)

- Have your camera at the ready as your time in Gros Morne National Park draws to a close. Travel through central Newfoundland on to Gander. Visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum which hosts a variety of artifacts and displays chronicling Gander's role in the development of transatlantic aviation.

Day 9 - July 3: Gander to Clarenville (B/L/D)

- A scenic drive along the rocky coast of Notre Dame Bay leads to the beautiful out port of Twillingate where you will visit Long Point Lighthouse and the Prime Berth Fishery & Heritage Centre. Keep your camera close at hand for wildlife as you drive through Terra Nova National Park and on to Clarenville, your home for the next two nights.

Day 10 - July 4: Bonavista & Trinity Touring (B/L/D)

- Today you will experience two quaint, historic towns. First, visit Bonavista, where John Cabot first arrived in North America in 1497. Learn about the hard life of the light keepers at Cape Bonavista Lighthouse Provincial Historic Site before continuing on to charming Trinity. Stroll the lanes and explore the many historic buildings preserved from the 18th century.



Day 11 - July 5: Clarenville - St. John's (B/D)

- Continue on to the intriguing old seaport of St. John's, your home for the next two nights. North America's oldest city and Newfoundland's capital boasts a stunning location in the granite cliffs and slopes of the Avalon Peninsula. Enjoy a city tour featuring the Victorian architecture of the downtown area, the busy modern waterfront, the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, Confederation Building, and the panoramic view from Signal Hill.

Day 12 - July 6: St. John's Touring (B)

- This morning, visit Bay Bulls for one of the highlights of your trip, a boat tour (weather permitting) in the Witless Bay Ecological Reserve to search for puffins and other seabirds. Next is a visit to the most easterly point in North America, Cape Spear National Historic Site. The afternoon is yours to explore St. John's at your leisure.

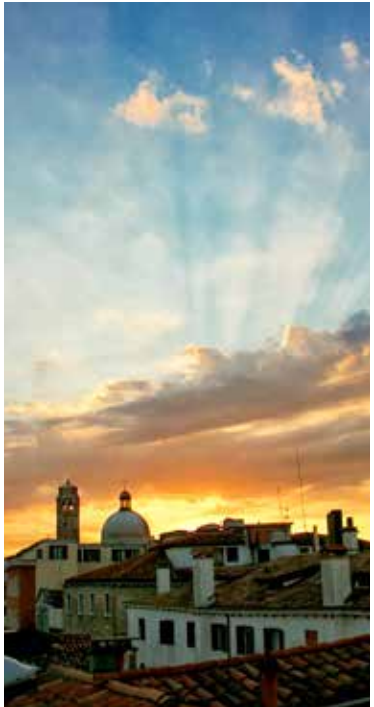
