



Southern Rockies, Drumheller,

Waterton Lakes National Park September 18-25, 2022: 8 Days

This is a great trip as you discover the best of the Canadian Rockies through Osoyoos, Cranbrook and the World Heritage site of Waterton Lakes National Park. Take a boat tour on Waterton Lake and find out what Head Smashed Buffalo Jump is all about. Explore Fort McLeod, birthplace of the North West Mounted Police. Visit the land of the dinosaurs at the Royal Tyrell Museum in Drumheller, AB. Return over Rogers Pass with a final night at the Three Valley Lake Chateau. Proof of full vaccination required.

Day 1-Sept 18: Home to Osoyoos, BC

- * You start your adventure on the Trans Canada Highway with a lunch stop in Hope
- * Travel through the Okanagan and Similkameen Valleys into your Lakeside accommodations In Osoyoos

Day 2-Sept 19: Osoyoos to Cranbrook, BC (B)

- * Today you coach through the Kootenays, a forested region surrounded by the mountain ranges. This area is treasured for its abundance of scenic beauty. Overnight stay at the St. Eugene Casino Resort.
- * Turn your clocks ahead 1 hr.

Day 3-Sept 20: Cranbrook to Waterton (B)

- * Crossing the Canadian Rockies via Crows Nest Pass you spend some time at the Frank Slide visitor center. Here you will learn of the massive 1903 landslide and see videos and displays of the local history
- * Lunch on your own in Pincher Creek before continuing into the town of Waterton. Your stay in Waterton is on the shores of the Lake. Take some time now to explore this afternoon.

Day 4 - Sept 21: Waterton, AB (B)

- * This morning join us for a scenic cruise on Waterton Lake stretching from Canada to U.S. (no passport required). Enjoy some of the most spectacular mountain scenery the Rocky Mountains have to offer. Bald eagles, bear, moose, deer, mountain sheep and mountain goats are often seen
- * Tour some of the highlights of Waterton National Park such as Red Rock Canyon and Cameron Falls

Day 5-Sept 22: Waterton to Calgary, AB(B)

- * Discover the world's oldest, largest and best preserved buffalo jump known to exist. The Head-Smashed Buffalo Jump, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, has been used by aboriginal peoples of the plains for more than 5,500 years
- * This afternoon explore the original home of the Northwest Mounted Police in Fort McLeod.

Day 6 - Sept 23: Calgary, AB (B)

- A great day exploring the coal mining and dinosaur area of Drumheller. Visit the Royal Tyrell Museum and be amazed at the history of massive dinosaurs.

Day 6 - Sept 24: Calgary to Three Valley Gap, BC (B,D)

- * Highlights today will be picture stops in Banff and Lake Louise and lunch on your own in Golden.
- * Enjoy the exhibits including railway models and informative film at the Rogers Pass Visitor Center
- * Relax and stroll the gardens of Three Valley Lake Chateau nestled beneath the Monashee Mountains
- * Chow down at a Group Barbeque after a guided ghost town tour and reminisce with new friends

Day 7 - Sept 25: Three Valley Gap to Home (B)

- * Return today through the Shuswap Lakes area and into Kamloops for lunch at a local Mall
- * Door to door home return.
